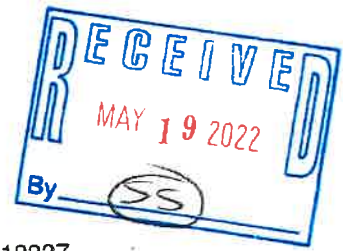

Re: Regional Sewage Services

Dear Milford Township Property Owner:

We write to you as the Municipal Authority of the Borough of Milford. You have probably heard about the proposed sewage project in the media or from friends. We are the governmental entity that will manage the construction and ultimate operation of the sewer lines and associated facilities to tie into the Westfall Municipal Authority and then provide sewage service to the Commercial District of the Borough of Milford. As you also may know Milford Township, where your property is located has decided that it will not mandate property owners within a prescribed distance of the sewage lines to hook up but that they may do so voluntarily.

This letter is intended to advise you of the advantage of committing to tapping into the system early as opposed to later. It is anticipated that the majority of the costs of the initial project will be covered by grants and loans. This will include the cost of installing laterals to each property. (The actual tie-in to the property owners' sewage line would be at the cost of the property owners.) Given that the line will run along US Routes 6 and 209 the cost of laterals after the main project is completed will be quite high. That entire cost would have to be paid by individual property owners who do not agree to connect initially; so there is a major advantage to doing so. Our commitment to you is that, if you agree to tap into the system before the project is tentatively approved by the DEP, we will charge you the same relative cost as that borne by the property owners in the Borough of Milford who will be connected.

Please notify us as soon as possible as to whether you want to be included in the main project or not. At this point your decision is not final but when we finalize the project for approval by the DEP and our funding sources, your decision will need to be finalized. You will then be notified to execute documents to fully commit. By then we will have much more in the way of detail to pass on to you. Please respond with the enclosed envelope and mail it back to us by June 30, 2022.
