Dear Parties & Counsel:

As you are aware, the Board of Supervisors of Milford Township has scheduled May 22, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. for the Conditional Use Hearing regarding National Land Developers. This Hearing will be held at the Delaware Valley High School Auditorium. The purpose of this correspondence is to request whether any party or counsel has any specific request for facilities to be made available so that we can transmit that request to the Delaware Valley School Administration prior to the Hearing. It is anticipated that tables will be set up for the Board of Supervisors and Counsel and a table for the individual protestants and Water Authority. Each table should have at least one microphone and although it is not anticipated that public comment will be reached at this early stage of the proceedings, there should be one additional microphone available in the event somehow we conclude the testimony and allow some sort of public comment.

In accordance with the Municipalities Planning Code, public notice will be given and the property will be posted prior to the Hearing. In addition, I am requesting the Township Secretary to procure the services of our court reporter for the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

I believe that if there are individual needs to be dealt with as far as audio or visual aids are concerned, that these requests should go to the Township Secretary as early as possible so that we may communicate them to the school and attempt to accommodate all parties and counsel. In addition, I will request the secretary to contact the school administration to see whether or not the parties and counsel may be able to have access at least 30 minutes prior to the Hearing in order to set up any displays or exhibits which they intend to use at the Hearing.

I want to thank the parties and counsel and the administration of the Delaware Valley School District for their kind cooperation and assistance in providing their facility for this important local matter.
