Auditors' Zoom Meeting January 5, 2021 Milford Township Building 7:00 p.m.

A scheduled meeting of Milford Township Auditors was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Patricia Stroyan through a Zoom call, the meeting ID for which had been advertised in advance in the Pike County Dispatch. Also present were Auditor Sharon Long-Abeson, and Secretary/Treasurer Shahana Shamim.

Ms. Long-Abeson made a motion to accept the minutes of the previous Auditor's meeting, which was held on March 10, 2020, Ms. Stroyan seconded, and it passed.

Road-Master's Salary:

Ms. Stroyan commented that this salary was previously set to \$20,000/year, and based on the job description, it is quite a fair amount. Sharon wondered if this salary was adequate for this job, which is pretty hard and entailed a lot, and she added that she expected the Road-Master to attend the meeting and provide a description of his duties. Ms. Stroyan added that although he is quite qualified to handle this job, he is not present at the meeting to ask for a higher salary, and hence it could not be raised. She asked the Secretary if he had ever asked for a raise, and the Secretary said 'no'. Ms. Stroyan made a motion to keep his salary the same, Sharon seconded, and it passed.

Treasurer's Bond:

Auditors commented that the Treasurer had provided the current bond, which was renewed for \$578, and this bond is valid from January 4, 2021 through January 3, 2022. Sharon made a motion to accept this bond, Ms. Stroyan seconded, and it passed.
