



Online Plans Display for Route 6 Project Near Milford, Pike County

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) invites the public to an online plan display regarding the Route 6 bridge replacement project. This project is located over Sawkill Creek along the border of Dingman and Milford Townships, approximately 4.0 miles northwest of the Borough of Milford.

The purpose of this project is to address structural deficiencies of the bridge and provide continued safe and efficient crossing at this location.

The project consists of replacing of existing structure with a precast concrete arch culvert. The new culvert will be placed in the same location as the existing structure and will allow for two 12-foot travel lanes, one 8-foot shoulder, and one 10-foot shoulder.

The bridge will remain open with a single lane that will be controlled with temporary traffic signals during construction. Pine Brook Road will be closed.

The project is currently in design and construction work is anticipated to take place in the 2027 construction season.
